

NOTICE: CHANGE TO NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM (NSP1) FUND USE:

The Department of Metropolitan Development is amending the 2008 Consolidated Housing & Community Development Annual Action Plan, which was ratified by the Common Council of the City of Evansville on December 2, 2008, as Finance Ordinance F-2008-17; to further define use of NSP1 Funds. Another option has been added to the activities listed for use of NSP1 Funds and beneficiaries of homes rehabbed, reconstructed, and new constructed, in the City of Evansville.

NSP1 (Neighborhood Stabilization Program) funds will be used to pay eligible closing costs in connection with FHA or other qualified mortgage loan options for the purpose of closing the sale of properties rehabbed or constructed using NSP1 funds.

The entire document can be obtained at Room 306 Civic Center Complex Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The amendment has a 15 business -day comment period beginning April 16, 2013.
